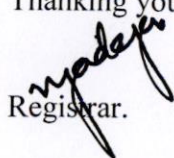

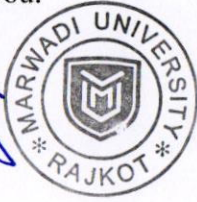

Subject wise result analysis included total number of students appeared for the exam and percentage of students passed in the exams conducted.

Item No. 10 – Hosting - Smart Gujarat - New India Hackathon, 2018.

The Institute support's and partner's with the initiatives launched by Government of India for creating smart cities under the Smart City Mission with an objective to promote sustainable-inclusive cities & smart solutions that provide core infrastructure enhancing the quality of life of its citizen, a clean sustainable environment and mechanisms for application of smart solutions.

The Government of Gujarat - Education Department has appointed Marwadi University as the regional Hackathon host and Mentor University for "Smart Gujarat for New India" Hackathon 2017-18. 160 Teams (@700 students) from various colleges of Gujarat will be participating in this 36 hour coding event which will be starting from 13th March, 2018.

The members of the Board are requested to consider the program and accord approval for financial expenditure in joint participation with Government of Gujarat.

It was proposed that seat intake shall be reduced from 120 seats to 90 seats.

Main Building / Hostels / Residential Quarter – 7 ha
Playground & other amenities – 3 ha
Farm Area, including godown/stores – 20 ha
Total Land area – 30 ha.

It was shared that as per the provision stated in Gujarat Private Universities Act No. 8 of 2009 under Chapter II, section 5 (xxv) which reads as “to purchase or to take on lease or accept as gifts,



bequests, legacies or otherwise any land or building or works which may be necessary or convenient for the purpose of the University and on such terms and conditions as it may think fit and proper and to construct or alter and maintain any such building or works”

Accordingly, it was proposed to lease below additional land area for the purpose of setting-up of Faculty of Agriculture studies.

Though the region is witnessing a fast growth, there is a dearth of trained nursing Institutes in the region. Hence, it was proposed to Introduce Nursing Program (ANM, P.B.B.Sc, B.Sc. – Nursing) from the Academic Year 2019-20.

The detailed project report on the proposed Nursing Program was presented, which stated Education & Employment opportunities, objectives and scope of the proposed Institute, requirements of

laboratories, space and cost of equipments etc. The SWOT analysis of the project was also presented for an in-depth study of proposed nursing program.

It was also presented that the Institute shall collaborate with Genesis Multi-specialty Hospital, Rajkot and Ashirwad Hospital, Rajkot as “**Parent Hospitals**” to have a practical and real-life exposure to medical studies. This collaboration, shall give more insight to students during their teaching-learning process.

The members present in the meeting discussed and resolved as below;

RESOLVED that the Marwadi University shall apply to Gujarat Nursing Council/Indian Nursing Council for introduction of Nursing Program (ANM, P.B.B.Sc, B.Sc. – Nursing) in the Faculty of Nursing under Marwadi Education Foundation’s Group of Institutions affiliated to Marwadi University.
