Objective:

 4. Successfully pass MOOCs course equivalent to 6 credits through SWAYAM Platform*
 5. Detailed literature review on any technical topic (At least 50 references should be included in the report to be submitted) At the end of the practice school, every student shall submit a printed report (in triplicate) on the practice school he/she attended (about 25 pages). Along with the exams of semester VII, the report submitted by the student, knowledge and skills acquired by the student through practice school shall be evaluated by the subject experts at the college level and grade points shall be awarded.
