Constitution, objectives, and functions of the Marwadi University Sports Committee (MU SC)

Objectives

The policy will focus to:

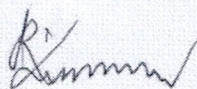
1. Organize and regulate sports activities.
2. Promote team spirit and sportsmanship among the university players.
3. Conduct tournaments annually in various games.

MU SC shall consist of:

Functions and powers of the Sports Committee

1. To frame rules for the organization of the Sports Committee and conduct of competitions.
2. To give decisions on any point not covered by the rules and approve the recommendations of executive committee.
3. To appoint committees for the selection of university teams.
4. To encourage the HODs of individual Department of MU to send teams to the university tournaments.
5. To adopt the Annual Report of the events conducted and activities done by the Sports Committee of MU.
6. To amend the rules or frame new rules or bye-laws as required.
7. To approve the Annual Sports Calendar of the university.



8. The quorum for the General Body Meeting of MU SC will be 1/3rd of the total membership of the exiting Sports Committee.

Duties and Powers of the President

- 1) The President will be the Chairman of the Sports Committee.
- 2) To Preside Over the meetings of the Sports Committee.
- 3) In the case of voting, the President shall have a casting vote.
- 4) In case of emergency, for any decision to be taken/implemented in anticipation. Such a decision will be placed before the Sports Committee in its next meeting for ratification.

Duties and Powers of the Senior Vice-President

- 1) The Senior Vice-President will act as President in the absence of the President.
- 2) The Senior Vice-President will exercise the powers vested in him by the Sports Committee.

Duties and Powers of the Vice-President

- 3) The Vice-President will act as President and in the absence of both the President and Senior Vice-President.
- 4) The Vice-President will exercise the powers vested in him by the Sports Committee.

Secretary

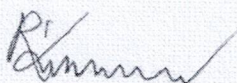
The functions of the secretary shall be as under:

- 1) To deal with the correspondence on behalf of the MU Sports Committee.
- 2) Implement all the decisions of the MU Sports Committee.
- 3) Convene all the meetings and record their minutes.
- 4) Responsible for the maintenance of all records and property of the MU.
- 5) Carry out all the duties which may be entrusted to him from time to time by the Sports Committee.
- 6) Make payments as per university rules.
- 7) Conduct tournaments and select teams of the University to participate in Inter-University Competitions.

Tournaments

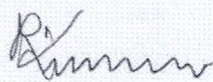
Tournaments in the following games given by Ministry of Sports, Govt. of India and some local games will be conducted on annual basis as per the rules of AIU.

Miscellaneous Rules

1. The Department of Sports shall prepare the Inter-Department sports calendar on annual basis.
2. Selection of players for the Inter-University teams will be done on trials Basis.
3. A coaching camp of at least 15 days will be held before the Inter-university competition.
4. No Substandard team will be sent for the Inter-University competitions.
5. Students Participating in the Inter-Department, Inter-University, State, National, International, or other such official tournaments will be considered on duty.
6. The special examination will be conducted for the sports persons who will participate in the Inter-University, National, or International Sports Competitions during their exams.
7. The competition will not be held if less than four Departments enter their teams.
8. Each Department is allowed to nominate only one team for a tournament.
9. All the matches will be played on a knockout basis.
10. If a team wants to protest it must be communicated to the Director of Sports within an hour.
11. If a team walks off the field of play during the match, it will be disqualified and the match will be awarded to the contesting team.
12. A team walking off the field of play as a protest against the judgment of a Referee shall be deemed to have lost the match.
13. If a sportsperson evades participation in the Inter-University competition, MU SC will take strict action against a such player(s).
14. Particulars of players must be filled in, on the prescribed eligibility Proforma and submitted in the office of the Director Sports in duplicate Seven days before the competition.
15. Eligibility Proforma must be signed by the Sports Coordinator of the individual Department of MU.
16. A student whose name is not included in the Eligibility Proforma will not be allowed to participate in the Inter-College matches.
17. Entries must be sent on the prescribed dates as per the schedule of the University mentioned in the sports calendar.
18. A responsible staff member of the department must accompany the team participating in the tournament.
19. Participation in the Annual Athletic Meet is compulsory for all the Department of the University.

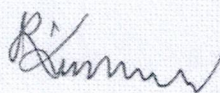


20. All teams will report to the Referee 30 minutes before the start of the match.
21. All players of the Team must be in a proper sports kit to play in the match.
22. No derogatory or offensive remarks will be allowed during the University Matches.
23. In case any member of a university team misbehaves, the matter will be reported by the Manager of the Team to the Director of Sports.
24. Merit Certificates and Medals will be awarded to the teams and individual players as per winning criteria viz. First, Second and Third positions in the Inter-College Competitions.
25. MU Champion Trophy will be awarded to the Department, which wins the overall General Championship in the Inter-College competitions.
26. A Trophy will be awarded to the Department which wins the Overall Athletics Championship.
27. Criteria for the Award of General Championship are as follows:
- A) Points for the team games
 - 1st Position - 30 points
 - 2nd Position - 20 points
 - 3rd Position - 15 points
 - B) Points for the individual sports
 - 1st Position - 05 points
 - 2nd Position - 03 points
 - 3rd Position - 02 points
 - C) Relays, Decathlon, Heptathlon
 - 1st Position - 10 points
 - 2nd Position - 06 points
 - 3rd Position - 04 points
28. Rules for the appointment of Captains of University teams will be as follows:
- A) Seniority in Inter-University participation.
 - B) Seniority in the class
 - C) Level of performance
 - D) Seniority in age
 - E) Good conduct.

29. Award of University Colour

University color will be awarded annually as per the following criteria.

- A) International Participants
- B) Position holders in the Senior/National Championships



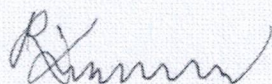
C) Position holders in the All India Inter University Championship/ Khelo India University Games

Sports Kit

Two sets of Sports Kit will be provided to the university players who represent MU in the Inter-University Competitions. The Sports Kit will includes T-Shirts, shorts, sports shoes, and Kit bag. Besides the Sports Kit, a Track Suit will also be provided to the Participating Players, Coaches and Managers once in a year.

TA/DA to the Players, Coaches, and Team Managers:

1. TA/DA to the players and Coaches/Managers will be paid as per the rates given below:
 - I) Players attending the coaching camp
Rs. 500/- per day per Head
 - II) Players, Coaches, and Managers representing MU in the Inter-University competitions. DA will be as under:
Rs. 500/- per head/ per day
2. 3 tier A.C train fare will be provided. Further, if a player/ Coach travels by Air/ by own vehicle/ by taxi will be reimbursed amount equivalent to 3 tier AC train fare.
3. If some players of a team travel alone by Air will provided only 3 AC train fare and will be allowed D.A at par with other team members from the date team departure from University till date of return back at MU.
4. In Special Cases only where emergency is established teams/ players/ officials will be allowed to travel by air. Director Sports / Sports representative of Director Sports will be allowed to travel by Air to attend officials meeting and competitions.
5. All Expenses will be paid to players by the University to participate in World University Games/Championships.
6. Any player/ team winning a medal will be given a rousing welcome on return to the University campus.
7. A sum of Rs.5000/- will be given to the Best Athlete selected among the boys and girls.
8. In the case of injury occurred to a player(s) during competition/journey/ West Zone Inter University/ All India Inter University/ Khelo India Univeristy Games the medical expenditure will be reimbursed as per the bill submitted by the concerned coach to Sports Department.



Officiating Charges

TA/ DA and officiating charges to the external officials conducting the university matches will be paid as under:

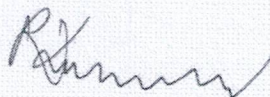
Rs. 1000/- per day and TA (As per university rules) For Inter Department Competitions.

TA/DA Will be given as per concerned federation rules for Inter University Competitions.

To encourage outstanding Sports Persons to give their best performance in the Inter-University and National Competitions, Incentive in the shape of scholarships as cash awards will be given as under:

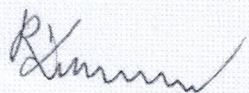
The above-mentioned amount could be enhanced from time to time.

Sports Quota seats have been reserved in the admission of the university to raise good teams for their participation in the Inter-University Competitions. The scheme is as follows:

SPORTS POLICY FOR ADMISSIONS AND BENEFITS TO SPORTS PERSONS

Guidelines for admission to the reserved category of sports

1. Relaxation will be given during admission in academic mark to meritorious sports person in all MU Programs. For example: minimum eligibility of marks is 50% in B.A, a meritorious sports person can get admission having Minimum Pass Percentage.
2. Each candidate will submit photocopies of all the sports certificates along with a photocopy of class 10th, 12th, and eligibility certificates.
3. The Vice-Chancellor shall have the authority to withdraw the benefits if it is found that the candidate has obtained such admission based on a false certificate.
4. Students seeking admission under this category will be considered for admission only in the games included in the 'MAKA' Trophy and Khelo India University Games.
5. Reservation under the sports category is meant only for those active sports persons who would participate in the Inter-University, National, and Inter-National Level Sports Competitions. Such students will be considered for admission only if: -
 - a) Their achievement in sports is related to the activities in any of the two years immediately preceding the years of admission.
 - b) They should be eligible for participation in Inter-University competitions.
 - c) Their achievement in sports is supported by continuous participation in sports in the same discipline.
 - d) During sports trials, if the performance of the candidate is not satisfactory the candidate can be rejected.



6. All the students admitted under this category will attend the ground.
7. In case a student does not attend the practice grounds or does not participate in the Inter-University Competitions on medical grounds, the medical certificate issued only by the university doctor will be accepted.

Gradation of Sports Certificates

The gradation for competitions other than World University Games/World University Championship , Khelo India Youth Games / Khelo India University Games , Inter-University Sports Championships will be considered provided these are recognized by the IOC, IOA, MYAS, and National Sports Federations.

Eligibility criteria

- **For 100% Sports Quota Scholarship :**

- i. Position or participation in any official International competitions recognized by IOA, MYAS, FISU, or National Sports Federations/ Associations of the concerned games.
- ii. Getting any of the first three positions in Senior National/ Federation cup/ All India Inter University competitions/ Khelo India University Games.
- iii. Getting any of the first three positions in Junior National/ SGFI National School games/ Youth National/ Khelo India Youth Games.

The following benefits will be given to the 100% Sports Quota Scholarship-Students.

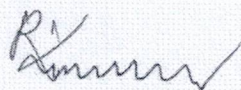
- i. Full fee waiver (Tuition fee, Admission fee, and Examination fee)
- ii. Free stay
- iii. Free Food nutritious diet

- **For 50% Fee Waiver Under Sports Quota Scholarship :**

Participation in Senior National/ Junior National/ SGFI National School Games/ Youth National/ Khelo India Youth Games/University Games.

- **For 20% Fee Waiver Under Sports Quota Scholarship :**

First three Position in State Level Competitions recognized by State School Games/Women Sports Festival/Khel Mahakumbh.



• **For 10% Fee Waiver Under Sports Quota Scholarship :**

Participation in State Level Competitions recognized by State School Games/Women Sports Festival/Khel Mahakumbh.

Note: A student without a sports certificate but having an outstanding performance during the trials can be considered for admission.

Off Campus/Outstanding Sportspersons

1. Off-campus outstanding sportspersons who are getting training at various centers of the country such as SAI centers, centers of excellence or any public or private academies are allowed to stay at their training centers.
2. These sportspersons will be considered on duty and they will be entitled to duty leave and all other benefits of regular students.

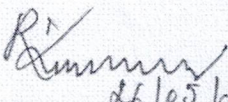

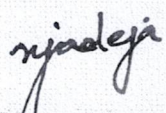
- a) International Medalists: Rs. 20000/- per head/ per month

- c) Senior National/ All India Inter University/ Khelo India University Games

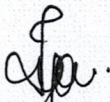
Gold Medalists: Rs. 12000/- per head/ per month

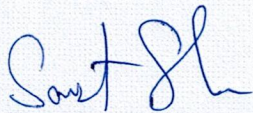

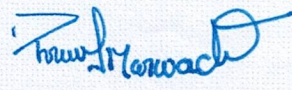
